=> Rochambeau Crosses Connecticut: The story of a French army of 4,000 soldiers and their supply train of wagons crossing a state whose roads and bridges were built for commercial traffic, skirted large swamps, and crossed rocky hills.

=> The March Heard 'Round the World!

=> Little-known Details of the Battle at Yorktown

=> Four Women in the Time of Rochambeau: a Queen, a Countess, a Future First Lady, and a Camp Follower

=> The Signing of the France-American Alliance in Paris: (in February of 1778) Not a hollow promise, it was followed by d'Estaing's naval attacks on British positions along the East Coast and the march of Rochambeau's army across Connecticut (good for a presentation in February)
